LESSON THREE

As we do a study of the first seven fruits at the fall of man, we see how God deals with each one through Jesus and the New Covenant.

God proclaims that if we walk in the Spirit, we will not fulfill the lusts of the flesh. Galatians 5:16

The Word proclaims that the Law gives power to sin, which comes from walking after the flesh. 1 Corinthians 15:55-57

**If we walk in the Spirit, we are not under the Law.
Galatians 5:18**

If we walk in the Spirit, we bear the fruit of God's Spirit, and against this, there is no Law. Galatians 5:22-23

When we, as believers, are led by the Spirit of God, we are manifesting so that the world knows we are His sons. We manifest the fruit and nature of God. Romans 8:14

**How do we walk in the Spirit, when the knowledge of good and evil has robbed man of a clean conscience? Through this knowledge, we have become as little gods, judging others and ourselves after the flesh, making us afraid of His presence.

**The evil conscience had to be dealt with.

The Blood of Jesus washed away the sins of the world, so that the Spirit could be restored to man, giving us the ability to walk with God.

Because of the Blood, sin and flesh cannot stop you from coming to God by Jesus Christ. Acts 2:21, Romans 10:8-13

Just as Iust drew man to walk after the flesh, now, through the blood of Jesus and the Holy Spirit, the Father draws us to Jesus and a walk in the Spirit. 2 Corinthians 5:19, John 6:44, John 6:65

Because Jesus was not serving the knowledge of good and evil, He only did and said what He saw and heard His Father do and say. This is what it means to be led by the Spirit. Even His judgments were by His Father, not after flesh and law.
